# 🐾 RVT Wellness & Vaccine Visit – What You Need to Know 🐾

Thank you for trusting us with your pet's care! This handout is to help you understand what happens during a Registered Veterinary Technician (RVT) wellness and vaccine visit, and what the limitations are. Please read carefully so there are no surprises at your visit.

### What This Visit Includes:

- A wellness exam by a **Registered Veterinary Technician (RVT)** not a veterinarian.
- Administration of vaccines (if your pet is healthy).
- Option to give a **single dose** of flea/heartworm prevention during the visit.

### **RVT Exam Fee: \$60**

## **X** What This Visit Does *Not* Include:

- No prescriptions or refills can be sent home.
- No medical concerns or illnesses can be diagnosed or treated.
- **No recurring medication** refills (like flea/heartworm or NSAIDs) unless your pet has seen a vet in the last 12 months (Can take 48 hours to refill).

#### If Health Issues Are Found:

If the RVT finds a health issue that might affect your pet's ability to safely receive vaccines:

- Your pet **must** be seen by a **veterinarian** first.
- We'll try to have the vet see your pet during the same visit, if possible.
- If the vet is unavailable, we may offer a **drop-off option** or help you **schedule a separate** appointment.

**Doctor Exam Fee: \$15 additional (total = \$75)** 

## **If Minor Issues Are Found:**

If your pet has a **minor issue** but is still okay to get vaccines:

- The RVT can proceed with the exam and vaccines.
- If you'd like a vet to also evaluate the issue, a **separate doctor exam (\$75)** will be recommended, depending on availability.

Combined RVT + Doctor Visit = \$135 (if both are completed)

# Nets NOT Eligible for RVT Visits:

- Pets with any health problems you want addressed.
- Pets on routine medications and/or wanting to start routine medications (e.g., flea/heartworm, pain meds) who haven't had a vet exam in the last 12 months.
- New pet over 7 years of age with chronic health issues

### Great Candidates for RVT Visits:

- Pets needing vaccines only
- **Puppies/kittens** getting boosters (if it's been 30+ days since their last vet exam)
- Pets that missed vaccines during a previous visit

### Quick Summary:

- RVT visits are for wellness & vaccines only
- No prescriptions or treatment during this visit
- If your pet needs a veterinarian, additional fees may apply
